"Rewilding the Mediterranean in the Changing Climate"



Rewilding the Mediterranean in the context of a changing climate is an evolving strategy aimed at restoring natural ecosystems, increasing biodiversity, and making the marine environment more resilient to climate change. The Mediterranean region, which includes parts of Europe, North Africa, and the Middle East, is particularly vulnerable due to its hot, dry summers and increasingly frequent heatwaves. Decades of overfishing and illegal fishing have taken a significant toll on the eastern Mediterranean coast of Turkey. Additionally, invasive species entering through the Suez Canal and rising water temperatures have led to the collapse of the marine ecosystem.
